POLICY STANDARDS FOR LIABILITY OR MALPRACTICE INSURANCE

1. Each Spiritual Care Practitioner, Psycho-Spiritual Therapist, or any other Member of CASC in the practice of professional spiritual care or professional counselling should carefully consider the value of both professional liability and general liability insurance, as CASC will NOT accept responsibility or liability, for any actions or misconduct of any member.
2. Members may contact the CASC National Office for recommended carriers and providers of insurance through a long term established liability insurance program that addresses the above mentioned requirements.
3. A lawsuit, whether justified or not, could drain the financial resources of your spiritual care or counselling practice. Be aware that individual misconduct is the sole responsibility of the Spiritual Care Practitioner, Psycho-Spiritual Therapist, or Member of CASC. Membership of CASC does not, in any way, imply culpability or liability on the part of CASC for any individual's misconduct, unethical behaviour, or criminal actions.
